


This week brings us into the second quarter of school. Next Thursday, parents and teachers will have the opportunity to meet and discuss student progress during the first quarter. It is good to take a look back to gauge how well our students are meeting academic goals and to make plans to help students be successful in the second half of this semester. It takes a team to nurture students' hearts and minds in order to help them become all they are created to be. Here are some tips for getting the most out of a 10-15 minute conference.

- 1. Review the report card, homework papers and tests.
- 2. Have a list of questions you'd like to ask.
- 3. Ask the most important questions at the beginning of the conference.
- 4. Take notes and write down anything you want to discuss further with your child.
- 5. Ask for explanations about anything you don't understand.
- 6. Respectfully discuss any differences of opinion.
- 7. Create an action plan for the second quarter.
- 8. If you need to schedule more time, ask the teacher about a mutually convenient day.
- 9. After the conference, keep in touch with the teacher.

Parents and teachers all have important perspectives to share. In working together, parents and teachers send the message that school is important and that we value the home and school relationship. We all want to provide the skills and knowledge that will enable our students to be happy and successful in school; the parent teacher conference can help find ways to reach this goal.
