

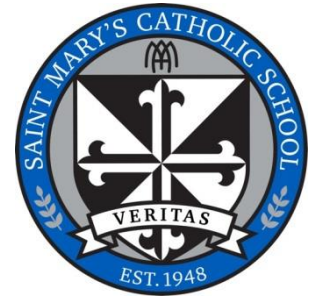

**Christmas Program (grades 1-5).** Christmas Program is Friday, December 15th at 7 pm in the school gym. Students will need to be at the school no later than 6:15pm. They go in the gym doors and directly up to their classrooms, taking all of their belongings with them. Please do not hold onto your child's coat, etc. as we always have a large crowd and seating is tight. A responsible adult must pick up your child from the classroom after the program due to school safety policy.

**Dress for Christmas Program.** Students should dress in church-appropriate clothing. Boys should wear pants and a shirt or sweater. Girls may wear pants or skirts and a top or sweater or a dress. Please keep in mind that they will sit on the risers at times, so skirts and dresses should be knee-length or longer. Tights are recommended, but not required. Tops and dresses must have sleeves that cover the shoulder. Girls may wear a short sweater or shrug if they wear a dress with straps or no sleeves. No shoes or boots with heels are allowed. Please wear shoes that are non-marking to protect the gym floor.

**St. Mary's Parish – Capital Campaign Study/Survey.** You may be aware that we are conducting a comprehensive survey of the entire parish. All parishioners received a letter from the pastor inviting them to participate. The purpose of the survey is to help gauge support for the following projects that constitute our parish master plan:

- Build a new entryway for our church
- Update our sanctuary, including the sound & hearing aid systems
- Renovate our church restrooms and parish center
- Complete needed maintenance in our school
- Reduce debt and bolster endowments
- Construct a bell tower

The goal for this Capital Campaign is to put St. Mary's on solid ground as we celebrate our first 100 years and embark on our second century as a faith community in 2021. Over 50% of St. Mary's School operations budget is funded by parish.
